Color Agent is a one part, air-drying, semi-paste ink commonly used for printing on hard surfaces including circuit board base materials.

Color Agent contains petroleum distillates but is not considered hazardous and does not require special labeling.

It can be used to tint the color of epoxy used for solder mask repair or circuit base board repair.

To use mix a small amount of color agent in with 2 part epoxy as the epoxy is initially mixed. Add more color agent to increase color intensity if needed.
