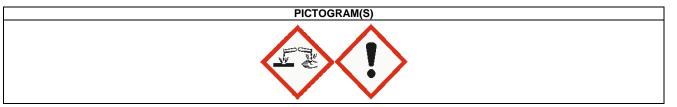

Clean-up methods:
